

BEST PRACTICES FOR VOTING IN PENNSYLVANIA

[Apply for a Pennsylvania Mail or Absentee Ballot today - and vote before October!](#)

Below, see the various Options - Vote Absentee (college students and members of the military who will not be voting from their home address), -OR- Vote by Mail or Drop-Box as shown below.

- **RECOMMENDED: Mail-in or early-voting ballot – Any qualified (REGISTERED) voter may apply for a mail-in ballot. You may simply request this ballot without a reason.**

Absentee ballot – If you plan to be out of the municipality on election day or if you have a disability or illness, you should request this ballot type, which still requires you to list a reason for your ballot.

Who may apply for an absentee ballot application?

- [College students](#) who are not registered to vote at their school address
- People whose work or vacation take them away from the municipality where they live
- Those with a physical disability or illness that prevents them from going to the polling place
- [Members of the military](#)
- People who may have a conflict due to the celebration of a religious holiday
- Inmates who haven't been convicted of a felony
- To vote by absentee ballot you must be [registered to vote](#).

BEST OPTION: Voting by Mail-in Ballot - You can vote starting in September!

Deadlines for the November 3 General Election:

- **5 pm October 27-** APPLICATIONS must be RECEIVED by your county election office
- **8 pm November 3 -** VOTED BALLOTS must be RECEIVED by your county election office - postmarks are not enough
- **Highly Recommended:** Apply Now for your ballot - just send in the form below - online is easy, or do it personally if you have no online access, see below.

Applications and ballots may be delivered to your [county election office](#) by the deadline. Contact your [county election office](#) for their hours of operation. In most PA counties, starting in September

You can drop off your ballot at a Drop-Box at the County Office - check with them~!

How to Apply for a Mail-in Ballot Online:

- **If you have no online access -** go to the County election office, and apply there - it's simple, with a driver's license or State ID.

Registered voters can apply for a mail-in ballot online with a [valid PA driver's license or photo I.D.](#) from the PA Department of Transportation (PennDOT).

Be sure to:

- Sign up to be a permanent mail-in ballot voter so you can automatically receive ballots by mail for the rest of the year.
- Provide an email address to receive notifications about your application and ballot status.
