Dr. Rob Goldston (@robgoldston) is a professor of Astrophysics at Princeton University. His areas of research are non-proliferation and arms control, as well as the physics of fusion energy. He was director of the Princeton Plasma Physics Laboratory 1997 - 2009. Goldston has written on the proliferation risks associated with nuclear energy, both fission and fusion. He was a lead author on the 2015 "29 Scientists" letter to President Obama, supporting the Iran Nuclear Agreement, and on a 2017 letter to Congressional leaders, signed by over 90 scientists, providing strong scientific support for the U.S. remaining in the Agreement. Dr. Goldston recently authored an article for the Bulletin of Atomic Scientists on nuclear declaratory policy, which he will speak on at the gathering.
