I am writing to urge your organization to **co-sponsor our 41st Annual Conference and Multifaith Service for Peace on Sunday, November 14 in Princeton, NJ.**

The event begins with an 11 AM **Multifaith Service** at Princeton University Chapel which is free and open to the public. Those attending in person must attest at the door that they are fully vaccinated, no children under 12 admitted. There will also be an option to watch on livestream.

Preaching will be the **Sister Simone Campbell**, who was Executive Director of NETWORK, the advocacy arm of Roman Catholic nuns in the US, from 2004 until March 2021. She is a religious leader, attorney, and poet with extensive experience in public policy, and perhaps best known for her leadership in the *Nuns on the Bus* project. Faith leaders from a wide range of backgrounds will co-lead the Service and will also include a free will offering to benefit CFPA.

Due to the continuing pandemic, we have decided to have the afternoon **Conference for Peace** as a **virtual Zoom event** from 2:30-4:00 PM. The start time is to allow those who may have traveled significant distance to attend the in-person Service to travel back and have lunch.

Speakers, in addition to **Sr. Simone Campbell**, will include:

Amb. Seyed Hossein Mousavian, is the former spokesperson for Iran in nuclear weapon negotiations with the international community. He will give an update on the Iran Nuclear Agreement and efforts to revive it.

Richard Moody is a former fighter pilot who served in the US Navy and the Royal Navy. He has undergone a transformation in his life and become an ardent peace activist with CFPA, as well as a practicing Quaker. His book about this, *Flying Through Life*, is about to be released.

Since there are reduced costs of doing the Conference online, there will be no fee to attend this year. However, to be sent the link **pre-registration is required** through peacecoalition.org.
