- Over 350 attend CFPA's 42nd Annual Conference and Multifaith Service for Peace on 11/14/21. The Multifaith Service with Sister Simone Campbell preaching and a wide range of faith leaders co-leading the Service, is a hybrid event with live attendees as well as those who join by livestream. Afternoon Conference for Peace, which Sr. Simone keynotes, is by Zoom and includes Prof. Rob Goldston and former fighter pilot Richard Moody as well. Some 34 area organizations co-sponsor.
- Over 500 attend hybrid Rally for Democracy CFPA cosponsors in Princeton on 1/6/22, anniversary of insurrection at the US Capitol. Extensive press coverage, including front page of two local newspapers.
- CFPA co-leads annual Martin Luther King Multifaith Service on 1/17, the official holiday in his honor, with 250 attending online, and another 100 watching the video afterwards, for a total of 350.
- Col. Lawrence Wilkerson speaks for CFPA webinar on Peaceful Alternatives in the Russia-Ukraine-NATO Crisis to 85 attendees on 2/6; about 1,025 view video afterwards for total of over 1,100!
- Over 400 total attend CFPA Princeton Vigil for Ukraine on 3/3 with front page coverage; and CFPA co-sponsored Philadelphia Rally for Ukraine on 3/6 with coverage in Philadelphia Inquirer.
- About 75 attend Annual Membership Renewal Gathering with Amb. Tom Pickering, who the NY Times recently called Dean of US Diplomats, on 3/20.
- About 75 attend Earth Week Webinar co-sponsored by CFPA and the Unitarian Universalist Congregation of Princeton on The Ecology of War on 4/24.
- June 2 Multifaith Prayer Gathering at State House in Trenton; and Rally against Gun Violence attended by 350 on 6/11 in Princeton precede NJ Gov. Phil Murphy signing seven new gun safety bills into law on 7/5! CFPA's Ceasefire NJ Project was statewide coordinator of grassroots support from across NJ for this important step forward!
- Rep. Tom Malinowski keynotes CFPA's 40th Annual Membership Gathering on 6/12, the 40th Anniversary of the historic Nuclear Freeze March in NYC attended by one million.
- CFPA's Peace Voter 2022 Campaign includes doing Candidate Briefings with Fetterman for Senate Campaign in PA, as well as with Tim Alexander in NJ District 2. Peace Voter Guides created for NJ District 2 as well as for NJ District 7, the closest race in NJ. Peace Voter Guides have over 300,000 exposures as half page display ads in newspapers in those two districts before Election Day!
- CFPA's 43rd Annual Conference and Multifaith Service for Peace attended by over 250 on 11/13. Speakers included Bill McKibben, Medea Benjamin, and Rabbi David Saperstein.
