HIGHLIGHTS OF ACCOMPLISHMENTS APRIL 2021- APRIL 2022

- CFPA co-sponsors, and Rev. Bob Moore is first speaker at Rally vs. Asian Hate on 3/27/21 in Princeton attended by over 3,000! Extensive press coverage in area media.
- About 60 hear experts on Iran Nuclear Agreement, and on Asian Hate, at annual Membership Renewal Gathering on Zoom on 4/13/21.
- CFPA co-sponsors, and Rev. Bob Moore speaks at Rally for Princeton University to Divest from Fossil Fuels on 4/24 on campus. Over 100 attend, with extensive press coverage in area media.
- Dr. Steve Pacala, expert from Net Zero Project based at Princeton University speaks at CFPA's Earth Week Webinar on April 29, 2021.
- CFPA's 40th Annual Membership Gathering via Zoom on June 10 keynoted by Rep. Ro Khanna, a top leader on peace legislation in the US House of Representatives, and honoring Daniel Ellsberg with a Lifetime Achievement Award. About 125 attend live or view the recording afterwards.
- In conjunction with Rev. Bob Moore's 40th anniversary as CFPA Executive Director on September 8, he is honored by Princeton Mayor and Council, NJ Assembly, and Rep. Bonnie Watson Coleman that same month. A hybrid Celebration of 40 Years of Peacemaking is the culmination of honoring him on 12/12/21 with over 50 in attendance.
- Over 350 attend CFPA's 42nd Annual Conference and Multifaith Service for Peace on 11/14/21. The Multifaith Service with Sister Simone Campbell preaching and a wide range of faith leaders co-leading the Service, is a hybrid event with live attendees as well as those who join by livestream. Afternoon Conference for Peace, which Sr. Simone keynotes, is by Zoom and includes Prof. Rob Goldston and former fighter pilot Richard Moody as well. Some 34 area organizations cosponsor.
- Over 500 attend hybrid Rally for Democracy CFPA cosponsors in Princeton on 1/6/22, anniversary of insurrection at the US Capitol. Extensive press coverage, including front page of two local newspapers.
- CFPA co-leads annual Martin Luther King Multifaith Service on 1/17/22, the official holiday in his honor, with 250 attending online, and another 100 watching the video afterwards, for a total of 350.
- Col. Lawrence Wilkerson speaks for CFPA webinar on Peaceful Alternatives in the Russia-Ukraine-NATO Crisis to 85 attendees on 2/6.22; about 1,025 view video afterwards for total of over 1,100!

- Over 400 total attend CFPA Princeton Vigil for Ukraine on 3/3/22 with front page coverage; and CFPA co-sponsored Philadelphia Rally for Ukraine on 3/6/22 with coverage in Philadelphia Inquirer.
- About 75 attend on Zoom Annual Membership Renewal Gathering with Amb. Tom Pickering, who the NY Times recently called Dean of US Diplomats, on 3/20/22.
- CFPA sponsors Webinar on Nuclear Danger and the War in Ukraine with Princeton University physicists and nuclear weapon experts Dr. Zia Mian and Dr. Stewart Prager attended by 75 live with 82 viewing the recording, on 3/27/22.
- CFPA's Affiliate Sacred Heart Peace Community hosts its Annual Gathering for Peace and Justice on Zoom on 4/2/22. The theme was American Democracy in Peril: How Do People of Faith Respond? About 50 attend live, and another 30 view recording, for a total of 80 viewers.
- About 75 attend Earth Week Webinar cosponsored by CFPA and the Unitarian Universalist Congregation of Princeton on The Ecology of War on 4/24/22.
