40th Anniversary Multifaith Service & Conference for Peace Sunday, November 10, 2019



Jim Wallis

(top left) will be the preacher for the morning Multifaith Service, and will also speak at the afternoon Conference.

Wallis is president and founder of Sojourners, a community with a Christian commitment to social justice. He is also editor-in-chief of Sojourners magazine, which has a readership of more than 5 million people. After the Service and at the start of the Conference, Wallis will be signing copies of his book, *Christ in Crisis: Why We Need to Reclaim Jesus*, where he argues that our cultural and political crisis largely stems from how the American church has become disconnected from Jesus's teachings.



Ray Acheson

(top right) is the Director of Reaching Critical Will, the disarmament branch of the Women's International League for Peace and Freedom. Acheson represents WILPF on the steering committee of the International Campaign to Abolish Nuclear Weapons (ICAN), a Nobel Peace Prize laureate.

Shiho Burke

(bottom left) is a daughter of two survivors of the Hiroshima bombing. She grew up in Hiroshima and now advocates for abolishing nuclear weapons.

Jenny Town

(bottom middle) is a Research Analyst at the Stimson Center and the Managing Editor and Producer of "38 North," a web journal that provides policy and technical analysis on North Korea.

Frank von Hippel

(bottom right) is a Professor Emeritus of Public and International Affairs at Princeton University, former Assistant Director of the White House Science Advisor's Office, and recipient of the MacArthur Prize (nick-named the Genius Award).

Dan Ellsberg

(top middle) will speak at the afternoon Conference, and attend a Sponsor Reception afterward.

While working for the RAND Corporation in 1969, Ellsberg privately photocopied a 7,000-page top secret study of America's intentions in Vietnam. He gave these "Pentagon Papers" to the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, and, two years later, to the *New York Times*, *Washington Post*, and 17 other newspapers. His main activity post-Vietnam has been anti-nuclear lecturing, writing, and activism, including work with Physicians for Social Responsibility. At the Conference, Ellsberg will be signing copies of his latest book, *The Doomsday Machine* (2017), a hair-raising account of the most dangerous arms build-up in the history of civilization, whose legacy threatens humanity's very survival.
